Liberating people from bonded chains of all forms of oppression has always been the main goal of the church initiatives. While continue to coordinate, collaborate and network with DSSS and other NGOs in this fiscal year, TASOSS has made a very significant role in building the people's movement had resulted in 465 of our CBO members got elected to the PRI, 75 Acres of common property pertaining to both land and water were recovered, more than 4 lakes and 20 farm ponds and 150 wells were restored, renovated and recharged, 16 producer groups were formed and 8608 marginalized households accessed various Government schemes to the tune of nearly 400 million rupees.

TASOSS took initiative by the guidance of TNBC has published the translated version of Aqua fons vitea in Tamil as “நீர் வாழ்வின் ஊற்று” and the encyclical of Pope Francis on Fratelli Tutti in tamil as “அனைவரும் உடன்பிறந்தோர்”. 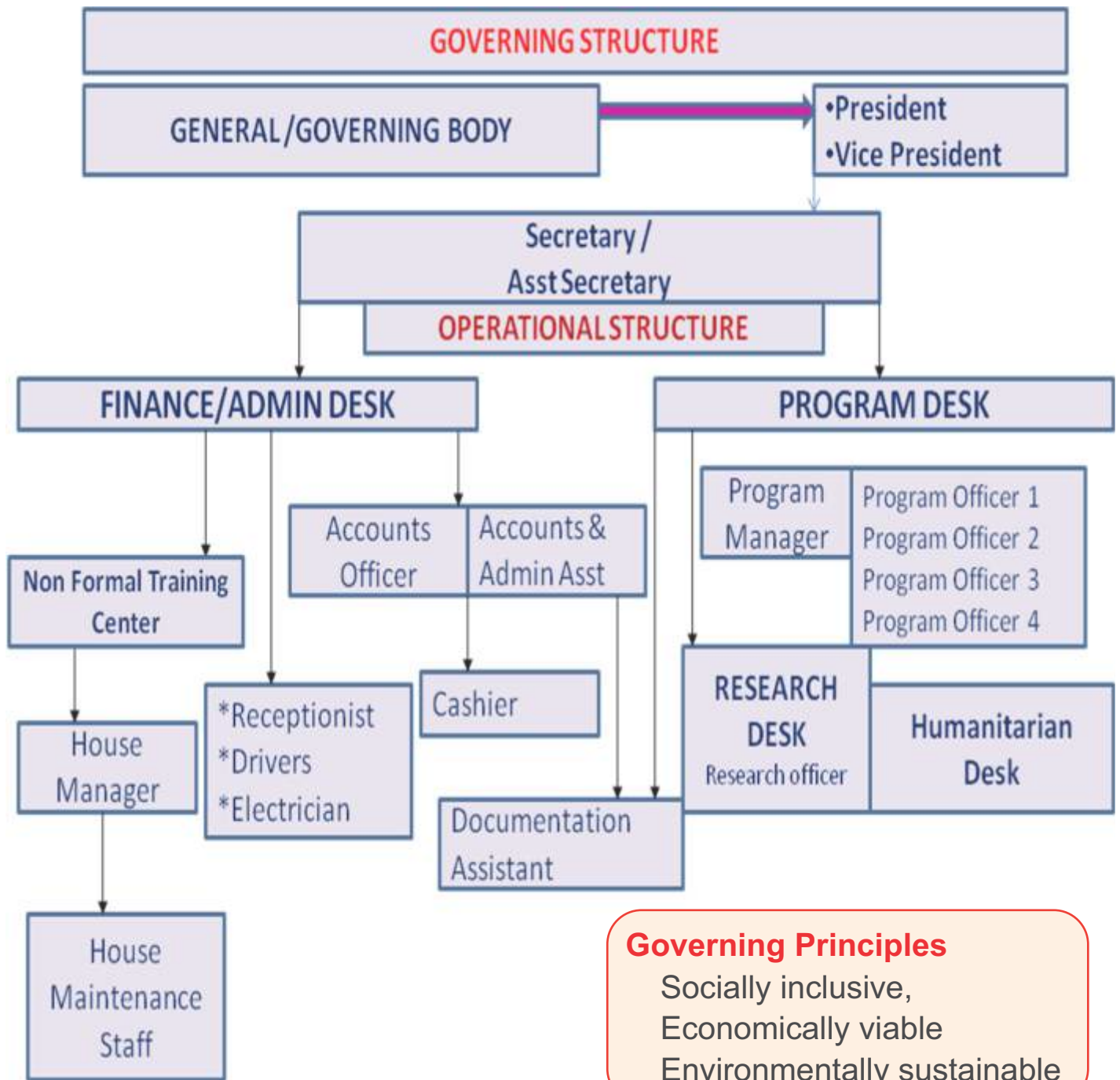

Key Results

2020-2021

Protection of Land and Water Resources

- TASOSS took up a professional documentation of various efforts taken up towards protecting the common property resources in particular Land and water in selected 6 DSSSs locations through a Micro research. The findings show that on an average more than 70% of the issues related to L&W were resolved.
- Totally 37 Land & Water issues identified in 6 DSSSs and resolved through the stake holders like CBO's, Volunteers and Cadres.
 - o Similar efforts are being made in 19 DSSSs locations which were documented and reported that 52 lakes have been recovered back.
- Supported and coordinated with Vallioor Multipurpose Social Service Society in restoring Anuman river.



- The Anuman river, originates in Western Ghats runs through 12 revenue villages for 32 kilometers. There are 7 supply channels and 11 anicuts across the river which feeds 47 PWD tanks.
- VMSSS coordinated with different stakeholders such as the district administration, local community, technical team from Anna University and the team of volunteers restored the Anuman nadhi river.



Key Outcomes as the REGIONAL COMMISSION FOR MIGRANTS in Tamil Nadu



- Migration Facilitation Centre (MFCs) - TASOSS facilitated in setting up of MFCs at 8 DSSSs locations – collected migrant data base in selected 40 villages, facilitating skill tie-ups for the migrants in need. This will be an information hub for updating the information related to in and out migrants of the location.
- Migrant Database created 6 dioceses (Kanyakumari, Thiruvallur, Chennai, Viruthunagar, Erode and Coimbatore).
- Migrants identified and skill building is in process and later they will be facilitated to link them with relevant government welfare schemes. (TASOSS published the relevant Resource material).
- Skill Development training in 8 DSSSs Covers min 40 identified uneducated, unskilled migrant youth (320+320 identified migrant youth) in each DSSSs based on their need such as Mason, Driving, Computer skills etc..
- TASOSS and DSSS staffs were capacitated to handle the WEB Application tool called KOBO for data collection and compilation.
- Tamil Nadu Women Federation contributed and included the issues of internal migrants in People's Manifesto 2021.
- 23 students from Tamil Nadu stranded in Maharashtra were rescued and sent to their native places by TASOSS during the COVID 19 lockdown period.
- TASOSS coordinated with the Kerala Regional forum and DSSSs to support 25 migrants who were brought from Kerala and sent to their native Districts across the state of Tamil Nadu.
- On the whole TASOSS through its diocesan partners reached more than 30,000 Migrants extending different services such as relief materials, food and psycho social support in response to COVID 19 response mission.



Govt schemes availed consolidation across 19 DSSSs CBO members:

- 250 Million rupees (25 Crores) have been sourced from government welfare schemes across 19 DSSSs.
- Nearly 145 Government welfare schemes such as OAP, green houses, widow assistance, sanitation etc and various other welfare schemes from different line departments were availed by nearly 12720 of our members.

Networking / alliance building / volunteer engagement:

- TASOSS triggers the process of Network Building or Collectivization processes of Child Leaders.
- TASOSS partnering with CRS in the global initiative of Change the Way We Care (CTWWC) facilitating the pilot study on 'Scope for Family based Care', engaging the 4 DSSSs in the Kanyakumari District.



- TASOSS is in the process of mapping the macro economic entity promoted by the 27 DSSSs for which a Tool was developed in participatory way, and discussed with the staff of DSSSs on 9th Dec 2020 who are mentoring Producers groups (PGs) and the data collection is under process. As of March 2021 16 PGs are functional in 6 DSSS localities.
- DSSS Directors reflected on 'Lenten Theme' and explored ways of strengthening the Lenten Campaigns – Lenten Message in Tamil (hand bill) released and disseminated in 'Nam Vazhvu 'Magazine.

Tamil Nadu Regional Strategic Plan - TNRSP

- TNRSP Core committee with the facilitation of TASOSS is in the final stage of completing the RSP Document for the Tamil Nadu Region. Aligning TNRSP with KSPs and SDGs are consciously adopted in each and every program plan, implementation and monitoring of TASOSS and the Partner DSSSs.



Covid Relief Activities



- RELIEF Activities carried out by 19 DSSSs were supply of PPEs / hygiene kits / groceries / essentials, providing Psycho social support / knowledge building / awareness and Networking and coordination with government organizations in relief mission
- 1500 families of the Marginalized Household in 57 locations were supported in COVID relief and other support activities
- TASOSS created a whatsapp group for volunteers combining all the key stake holders of TASOSS such as the staff of TASOSS and its member societies, Women Federation EC members, Directors of member societies etc.
- TASOSS along with its key stakeholders at the ground level have started our mission in the process of supporting our people in concern through different ways such as virtual meetings, volunteerism, knowledge building etc.
- Prepared, Translated and Printed 20,000 notices having awareness information on COVID-19 This was disseminated to all our key stakeholders such as the DSSSs, Tamil Nadu Women Federation, TNCRI and other Commissions
- TASOSS associated with SPHERE India and Red Cross organization in preparing and releasing resource materials related to the humanitarian services, dos and donts during this crisis etc.
- Psycho-social support through tele-counseling to the people affected by COVID 19 either as infected or as the persons affected indirectly. (A team of counselors comprising TASOSS Directors and nuns from catholic religious Institutions CRI)
- The team provided support at two levels collaborating with the Trichy City Corporation wing and by creating a counseling desk at TASOSS level (April to May 2020)
- Trichy City Corporation has appreciated and acknowledged the team by issuing a service certificate authorized by the Corporation Commissioner
- 23 students from Tamil Nadu stranded in Maharashtra were rescued and sent to their native places by TASOSS
- TASOSS coordinated with the Kerala Regional forum and DSSSs to support 25 migrants who were brought from Kerala and sent to their native Districts across the state of Tamil Nadu
- Online meeting with the DSSS Directors and point persons towards orienting them for quarterly activities related to COVID 19 relief work in the targeted locations. (28th May 2020)
- A video documentary on the COVID relief activities across the state facilitated and coordinated by TASOSS was produced and disseminated in Madha TV
- A compilation of COVID relief activities was prepared and published in the 'Nam Vazhvu' tamil weekly magazine.

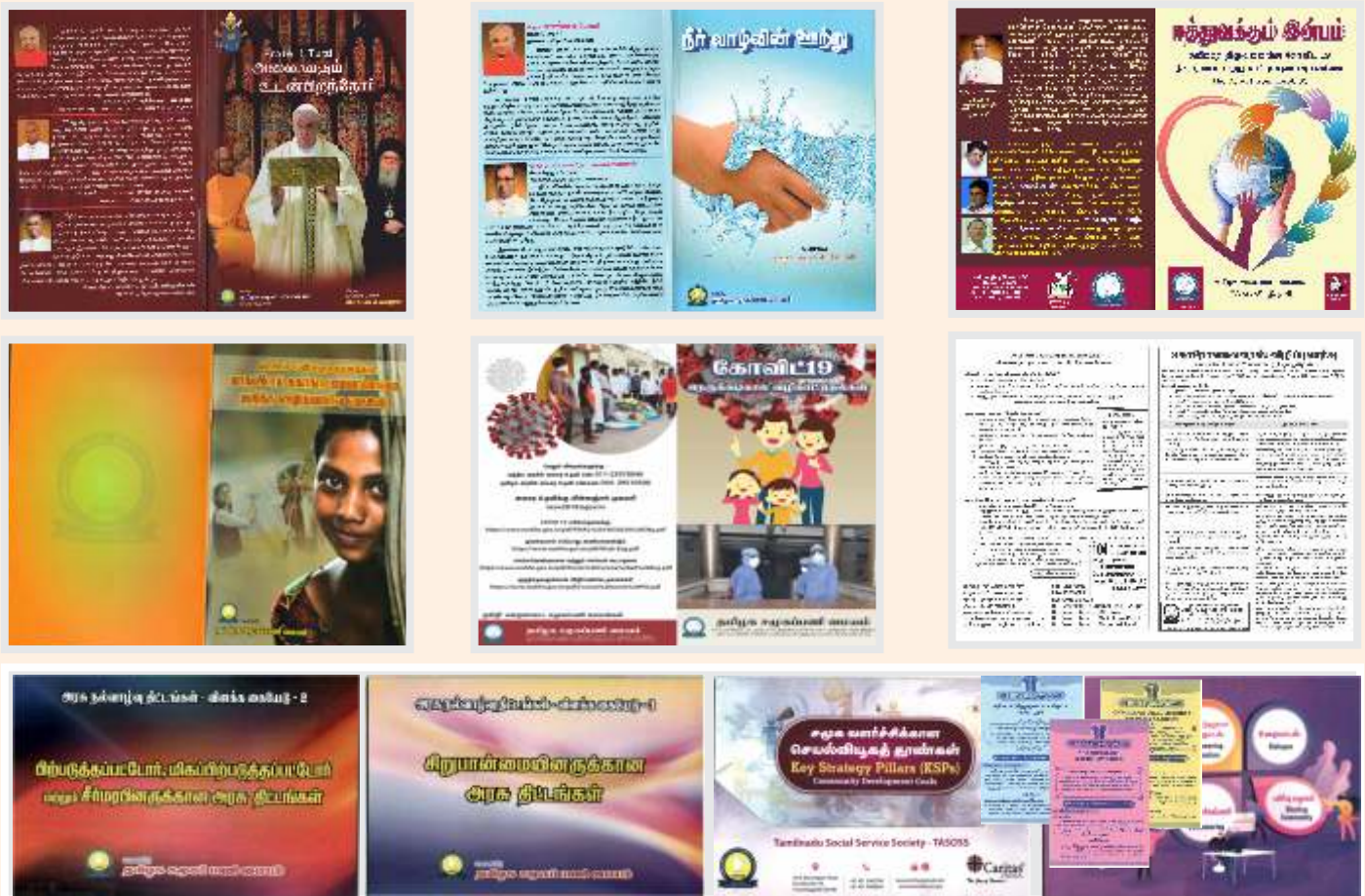

- TNBC recommended TASOSS to publish Aqua fons vitae, since it analyzed the challenges and gives suggestions for concrete commitments towards sustainability of water; Particular emphasis at the local level to be taken to protect the water sources.
- Government welfare schemes pertaining to SC/ST, Minorities, BC and MBC were compiled and prepared as a handbook.
- Menstrual Hygiene Management hand book– released on 22nd Feb 2021 and disseminated to All 27 DSSSs.
- Key Strategic Pillars (with indicators) – released on 22nd Feb 2021 and disseminated to All 27 DSSSs.
- The encyclical of Pope on 'All Brothers' was translated to vernacular language and published by TASOSS and disseminated.
